seeing all of our carving community's work, you are so talented!

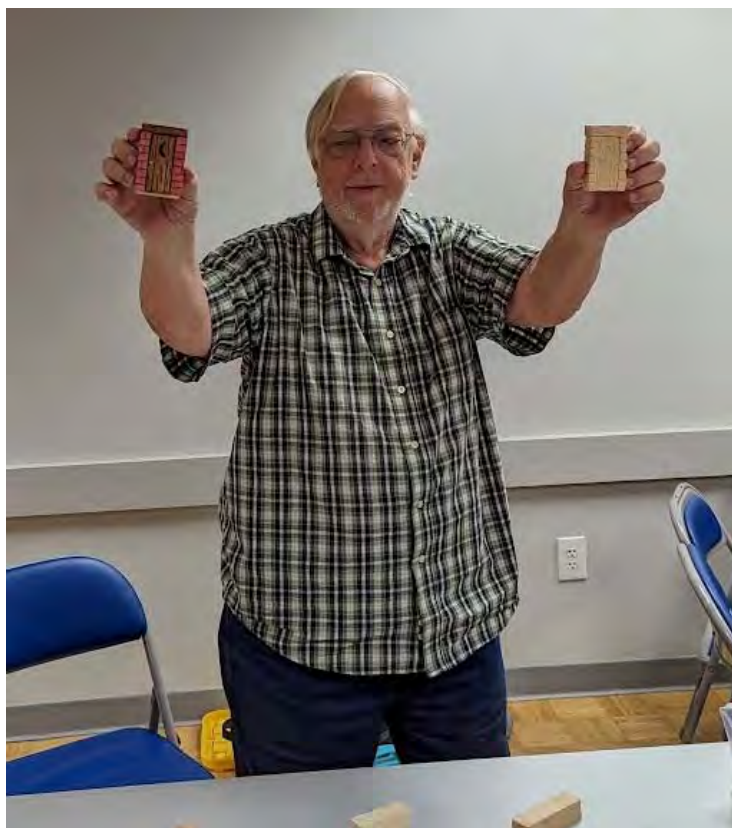
