2-Day Class

Class Cost: Cost \$60

Participants: 8 to 12

Skill Level: Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced

Tools Required: Glove, Chip Carving Knife. Light would be helpful.



Class will involve a choice of chip carving projects suitable for the different skill levels. Class projects range from ornaments, to crosses, to boxes, to round plates. Students will learn how to hold the knife and techniques in basic cuts including rosettes. Also lettering instruction is available as part of the class. A practice board is included in the base \$60 fee. A project fee, depending on the project, ranges from \$2 to \$18.

Class Cost: Cost \$70 and \$90

Participants: Minimum of 8-12

Skill Level: Intermediate & Advanced.



Class includes the choice of two carving projects — a relief/intaglio project and a Texas Mosquito carving, which Wanda describes as a fun project. The mosquito can be carved as a baseball player or it can be carved wearing a cowboy hat, wearing boots and carrying a Texas flag. Blanks will be provided. The relief project is \$70 and the mosquito project is \$90.

Class Cost: Cost \$90

Participants: Minimum of 6-8

Skill Level: Intermediate & Advanced

Tools required: Glove, Knife, Palm Tools, V Tools, Gouges, etc.



This Carving Class features carving a half-size Green Heron. Emphasis will be on teaching bird carving techniques, including feather group location and carving details to make it a realistic and interesting carving. A cut out of the Heron will be provided by the instructor.
